Apply for a full-time place in Reception

The local authority is still taking applications for school Reception places for the next academic year (2023/24). The online application system opened in early November. The Closing Date for applications is **15th January 2023**. Submitting your application on time is important as a late application may affect your offer of a school place - last year, 94% of on-time applicants were offered a place at their 1st Preference school, compared to only 56% of late applicants.
